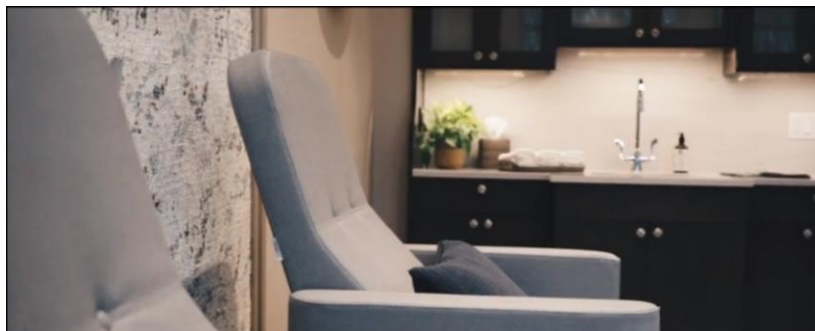


ANNOUNCING THE ELEVATED LOTUS SALON AT THE LODGE AT WOODLOCH
